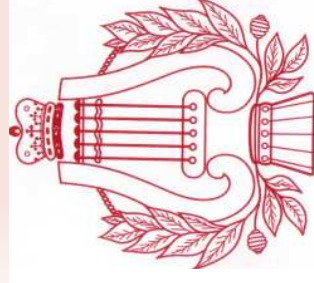


Our Mission

Although he majored in clarinet, his other instruments include recorder, flute, saxophone and French horn and he has taught music for over 30 years.

He has worked in Government secondary schools, Catholic and independent schools and has been Director of Music and Faculty Head of Performing Arts at St Leonard's College in Brighton. He teaches both VCE and IB Music.



Barry has been a soloist with the South Melbourne Symphony; played professionally with the Australian Dance Theatre Company; conducted the Monash University Symphony Orchestra and the Southern Peninsula Concert Band (for more than 25 years) and has been a guest conductor and adjudicator for various schools and festivals.

Barry continues his work with the VCAA (VCE assessment platform) where he is an external assessor for both Music Performance and Music Investigation.
